Research internship in plant evolutionary ecology (Forskningspraktik i växtekologi och evolution)



My name is Nina Joffard, and I am a postdoc fellow who will join the Dep. Ecology and Genetics at Uppsala University in April 2019 to work on the fragrant orchid *Gymnadenia conopsea* and its close relative *G. densiflora*. The aim of my project is to study the consequences of **coexistence** between the two species on the **selection** exerted by **pollinators** on their **floral traits**, particularly on **scent**. I will conduct my first field season in **June - July 2019** in the island of **Öland** and I am looking for students interested in doing a research internship to help me in the field. Fieldwork will include **morphological measurements, floral scent sampling, hand-pollination experiments** and **pollinator catches**.

As an intern, you will join us in the field for a few weeks and write a short report. You will get 10, 15 or 20 credits depending on the number of weeks you will participate in the project (**course code: 1BG363, 1BG364, 1BG365**).
